**SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE COMBINED JOINT AFRICAN EXERCISE  
(CJAX) 2010 WORKING GROUP 19-23 JULY 2010**

- A. Minutes of the Combined Joint African Exercise (CJAX) 2010 Working Group 8-10 Mar 2010.

1. Further to the detail at Reference B, these supplementary instructions aim to complete the information required prior to attendance at the Integrated Mission Planning Process (IMPP) Train the Trainer (T3) Seminar and CJHAX Final Coord conference 19-23 Jul 2010.

2. Agenda. There is no change to the agenda indicated at Reference B, however the programme of events has been simplified and refined (see Annex A). It will comprise;

- a. 19 Jul – Travel Day
- b. 20 Jul - IMPP Train the Trainer Day (T3).
- c. 21 Jul – Military Operations Other Than War (MOOTW) and PSO Training Discussions – to include SANWC handover of their MOOTW module as a start point for establishing “best practice” in SADC Colleges.
- d. 22 Jul – CJAX Final Coord Conference
- e. 23 Jul – Spare Morning / Travel Day

3. Guest Speakers.

- a. UNDPKO - Mr Nicholas Seymour, Senior Political Affairs Officer from the Africa 1 Division United Nations Department of Peacekeeping Operations (UNDPKO) has confirmed his attendance.

- b. AU PSOD - Attendance of an Officer from AU PSOD has been requested and is TBC.
- c. SADC Planelm - Attendance of an Officer from SADC Planelm has been requested and is TBC.

3. Working Group Attendees. Colonel Willie Sikazwe has replaced Col Oliver mooned as the senior Zambian delegate.

4. Administration and Movement for the CJAX Working Group.

a. Movement.

- o The Zambian delegation (2) will arrive at ORT as indicated below. They will be met by a SANDF driver and escort and taken to their accommodation. Daily transport will be arranged for the Zambian delegation
  - Arrive ORT 19 Jul at 1545 on SA 0063
  - Depart ORT 23 Jul at 1545 on SA8164
- o The Batswanan delegation will arrive and depart the Working Group in their own vehicles. They will self drive daily to the Working Group, they will be able to follow the Zambian delegation on Day 1.

d. Directions to the Guesthouse are

From Johannesburg International (OR Thambo)

- Take the (R21) towards Pretoria
- Turn left at N1 South , Johannesburg
- Take Botha Avenue Off ramp
- Turn right in Botha Avenue.
- Turn Left in Cantonment Avenue
- Turn left into Selborne Avenue (no 123)

From Johannesburg (N1-North)

- Take the Botha Avenue off-ramp
- Turn Left in Botha Avenue

- Keep on Botha and Turn Left in Cantonment Avenue
- Turn left into Selborne Avenue (no 123)

From Pretoria (R28)

- Take the Jean avenue off-ramp
- Keep left past the garage
- Turn left into Rabie street (look out for Unitas Hospital)
- Turn Right In Selborne Avenue (no 123)
- From Pietersburg (N1)
- Take the Botha off-ramp
- Turn right into Botha avenue
- Turn left into Cantonment avenue
- Turn Left Into Selborne Avenue (no 123)

- f. Working Group Dinner. No Change.
- g. Financial Arrangements. All breakfasts and lunch meals, plus the evening meal on 21 Jul will be provided. The standard UK military subsistence allowance of R133 per evening meal will be issued – 3 nights total = R400 / person. All other agreed costs of the Working Group will covered by BPST(SA).
- h. CJAX Exercise Instructions. It is requested that all delegates familiarize themselves with Reference C. The Academic instructions for CJAX will be issued on arrival.
- i. CJAX 2011 Planning. If possible it would be very advantageous for the Working Group to agree a provisional date for CJAX 2011 (suggest late Sept), a date for a Working Group early in 2011 (suggest end of Feb), and a date for a Final Coord Conference (suggest some time in June/July). If delegates have any specific request for the location of the Working Groups, this can be accommodated, as it is not tied to Pretoria and it may be deemed of more value to hold them at one or both of the other Colleges. It would be appreciated if delegates can consult their long-term planners / Commandants so that this debate can be informed.
